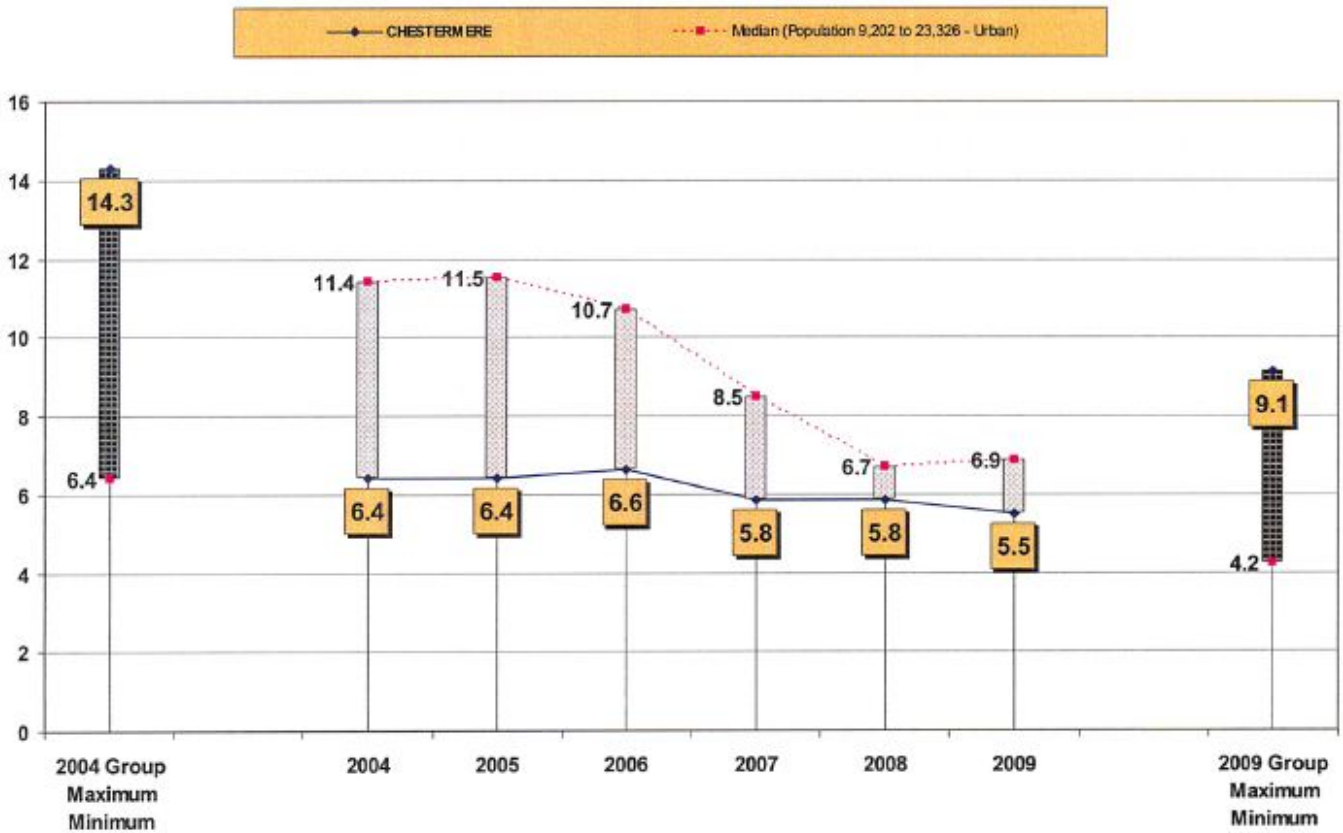


Chestermere Tax Rate Comparison

The graph below is provided by Municipal Affairs and shows the different tax rates of urban municipalities close to our population (9,202 to 23,326).

The red dots show the median tax rate for municipalities close to our population. The blue diamonds and numbers in yellow boxes along the bottom of the graph show Chestermere's tax rate for the past several years. The grey bars show the difference between Chestermere's tax rate and the median tax rate. As you can see, Chestermere is usually quite a bit lower than the average tax rate for Alberta municipalities close to our size.
