

**BY-LAW 023-11
OF THE TOWN OF CHESTERMERE
IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA**

A By-law of the Town of Chestermere to amend By-law 043-08, being a by-law to authorize assessing property owners' monthly garbage collection and disposal utility charges designed to meet the general maintenance or management or conduct, or any of them, of the Town of Chestermere Waste Management System.

WHEREAS it is deemed expedient and proper pursuant to the *Municipal Government Act*, being Chapter M-26.1 of the revised Statutes of Alberta and amendment thereto, that Council shall issue a By-law for the general maintenance or management or conduct, or any of them, of the Waste Management System of the Town of Chestermere.

NOW THEREFORE, the Municipal Council of the Corporation of the Town of Chestermere, in the province of Alberta duly assembled, enacts as follows:

1. Section 21 is replaced by the following:

Effective September 1, 2011, the Town shall provide a weekly standard collection service of four (4) garbage bags or two (2) receptacles to all residential properties located within the collection area. If residents choose to use receptacles, they must ensure that the contents are bagged.

- a. Loose garbage in receptacles is prohibited. Residents who do not bag their waste will not have their garbage collected.

2. This Bylaw comes into full force and takes effect on the date of third and final reading.
