The Community Services Department is accepting résumés for the full-time position (37.5 hours per week) of Turn Around Worker. Reporting to the Community Development Manager, the position will be responsible for:

- working in partnership with local RCMP to address risk behaviors and crime involving youth aged 12 to 24;
- liaising with Probation Services, the Youth Justice Committee, Victim Services and the Crown Prosecutor's office (when appropriate);
- acting as a resource to school and other community organizations or groups dealing with high risk youth
- receiving referrals from multiple sources to develop a caseload of at-risk and high-risk youth and young adult clients;
- working preventatively with a small caseload of clients and their families to assist them in developing healthier lifestyles, free of illegal activity; making appropriate referrals for specialized services, developing supportive relationships;
- working with youth to assess their risk and protective factors and jointly developing a plan to work together to address these factors;
- attending court and preparing supporting documentation;
- ensuring that outcomes are met as set out in the project's Logic Model;
- collecting program evaluation data as directed;
- regular reporting to the steering committee through the Healthy Community Initiative;
- making presentations to community stakeholders;
- other duties as assigned.

Applicants must possess post secondary education in Social Work with a minimum of three years front line youth experience. An equivalent combination of education in a related field and experience may be considered.
