Proclamation International Day for the Elimination of Racial Discrimination

WHEREAS: the City of Chestermere is committed to the belief that equal opportunity and equitable treatment should exist for all people; and

WHEREAS: every resident of the City of Chestermere has the right to realize their potential, regardless of race, colour, cultural, or ethnic origin, and live at all times in conditions of dignity, respect, and peace; and

WHEREAS: in 1966 the General Assembly of the United Nations designated March 21 as the International Day for the Elimination of Racial Discrimination; and

WHEREAS: the elimination of racism and racial discrimination can be accomplished through mutual understanding, acceptance and respect for the dignity of all people and rights of all people; and

WHEREAS: the elimination of racism and racial discrimination is the social and moral responsibility of each person.

NOWTHEREFORE: I, Marshall Chalmers, Mayor of the City of Chestermere, do hereby proclaim **March 21, 2021** as **International Day for the Elimination of Racial Discrimination** in the City of Chestermere.
